Social areas of the Club, the Changing Rooms and the Drive, to complement the wonderful playing facilities that we now have since the recent Land Development.

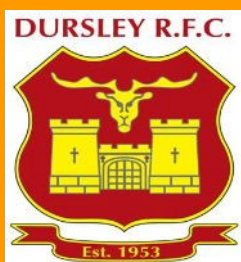
We have 1300+ Members in our club. If we have to raise £250k ourselves as the Club, this is equal to just £200 per Member.
